Dear Parents,

Please be aware that St. James Parochial School has been inspected by an accredited inspector, as required by the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Act of 1986 (AHERA). AHERA requires Local Education Agencies (LEA'S) to identify asbestos containing materials (ACM) in their school buildings and to take appropriate actions to control the release of asbestos fibers.

The buildings are inspected every six months to determine any changes in the condition of identified ACM and is re-inspected every (3) years by an accredited inspector following the same criteria as the original.

St. James School maintains a complete updated copy of the Asbestos Management Plan in the school office. The Asbestos Management Plan is available during school hours, without cost or restriction, for inspection by representatives of EPA and the State, the public, including, teachers, parents, and other school personnel and their representatives.
